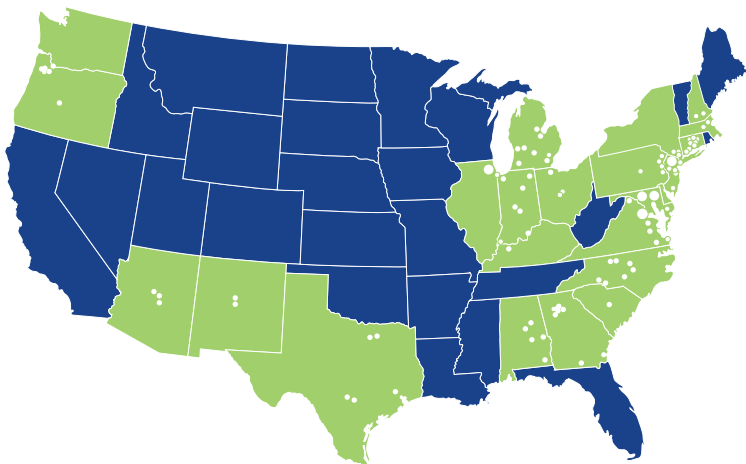

He has established criteria and protocols for vascular diagnosis and has pioneered and contributed to methods of treatment. He is on the editorial board of many journals, having more than 350 publications and 4,000 citations (h-index 77). He has edited five vascular textbooks and has contributed over 65 book chapters on the diagnosis and management of vascular diseases.
